It also aims to enable students to train on various psychological examination techniques and control their procedures, as well as diagnostic methods based on various detection methods, whether projective or objective in their social and cultural framework for the examinees.

In addition to training students to prepare scientific research based on the clinical approach and to provide suggestions to take care of cases.

It can also reveal problems that could be topics for research in the field of master's and doctoral studies within the framework of the laboratory or research units
